## History

The school started with seven students and two dedicated teachers in the basement of their house. This number has grown to over forty students and five devoted teachers. ## Classes

Bangla School offers Arabic, Bangla, vocal music, and traditional dance. Arabic classes start at 10:00 am every Saturday. Every class proceeds for one hour. We have three levels Bangla class-beginners, intermediate, and advanced. Classes cover Bangla reading, writing, conversation, literature, and history. Vocal music starts at 12:15 pm. The students learn the fundamental basics of Bangla *gaan* to a variety of songs ranging from *Rabindrosangeet*, *Nazrulgeeti*, *adhunik*, *Deshher gaan*, etc. Lastly, we have dance class. Our students learn the essential principles of dance and various types of Bengali dance. Our vocal music and dance classes perform at all of our programs.
